

LASH Hearing Assistance Procedures

Complete the following forms:

LASH Hearing Assistance Request

Towson University Application for Reduced Fee

Proof of Income Information

Submit them and the **\$25 Non-refundable application Fee** to the LASH Hearing Coordinator.

All of the forms and the Federal Poverty guidelines are downloadable from www.LASHmaryland.org.

The LASH Hearing Coordinator will review the information provided and, if the client is eligible, send a referral to the speech, Language and Hearing Center with a copy to the client and referring Club coordinator. Towson will not accept a patient without this referral.

REFERRALS WILL BE VALID FOR A PERIOD OF ONLY 30 DAYS. The Club coordinator or the client is responsible to see that an appointment is made with the Hearing Center within those 30 days or a NEW referral number will be needed. The client will have to make at least three visits to the Hearing Center for testing, fitting and final adjustment.

When the aids have been provided, the bill for services will be sent to the LASH Hearing coordinator. The LASH Treasurer pays the provider. A bill will be sent to the referring club for reimbursement. The club works out the reimbursement options with the client and forwards a club check to LASH.
